



CROCHET PATH



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What do you need:

- *medium* yarn (at a recommended hook size of 4-6 mm). I used Bohème Velvet Double (in colour "Brown (17635)"; gauge: 10 cm = 18 M)
- I worked with a hook of size 5.00 mm
- Scissors

Skill level: easy

Finished length of the path: appr. 60 cm

The instruction is written in **American English Crochet** terms.

Abbreviations:

sc = double crochet / *inc* = increase / *dec* = decrease / *st*, *sts* = stitch, stitches / *sl st* = slip stitch / *ch* = chain

You crochet in **rows** of single crochet **stitches**. At each row end, ch 1 and turn your work; in the next row, skip the turning ch 1 and start working in the first st thereafter.

The number in the brackets at each row end indicate the new number of sts (excl. the ch st before turning your work).

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How to read the instructions:

I abbreviate several consecutive stitches as the number worked:

"**5 sc, inc (7)**" means that you work 1 sc in each of the next **5 sts** and 2 sc in the 6th stitch, getting a round of 7 sts.

"**4 sc, dec (5)**" means, likewise, working 1 sc in each of the next **4 sts** and, then, crocheting the 5th & 6th st in a sc together, reducing the round from 6 to 5 sts.

For the inc and dec sts, I shorten several consecutive increases/ decreases in terms of *y-times* (stated as *x*):

"**2x inc**" means that you increase the next 2 sts, thus, working 2 sc in each of the next 2 sts (getting 4 sc in total).

"**3x dec**" means that you sc each of the next 3 st-pairs together, thus, sc the 1st & 2nd st together, the 3rd & 4th, and the 5th & 6th.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CROCHET PATH

Ch 4 + turning ch 1

At each row end, make 1 turning ch, which you then skip at the start of the next row.

1. – 5. Row: 1 sc in each st across (4)

6. Row: 2x inc, 2 sc (6)

7. – 10. Row: 1 sc in each st across (6)

11. Row: dec, 4 sc (5)

12. Row: 1 sc in each st across (5)

13. Row: 4 sc, inc (6)

14. - 16. Row: 1 sc in each st across (6)

17. Row: 5 sc, inc (7)

18. Row: 1 sc in each st across (7)

19. Row: dec, 4 sc, inc (7)

20. + 21. Row: 1 sc in each st across (7)

22. Row: inc, 4 sc, dec (7)

23. Row: 6 sc, inc (8)

24. + 25. Row: 1 sc in each st across (8)

26. Row: inc, 7 sc (9)

27. – 29. Row: 1 sc in each st across (9)

30. Row: inc, 8 sc (10)

31. – 36. Row: 1 sc in each st across (10)

37. Row: dec, 7 sc, inc (10)

38. Row: inc, 7 sc, dec (10)

39. Row: dec, 7 sc, inc (10)

40. Row: inc, 7 sc, dec (10)

41. Row: 1 sc in each st across (10)

42. Row: inc, 7 sc, dec (10)

43. Row: 1 sc in each st across (10)

44. Row: inc, 7 sc, dec (10)

45. Row: 1 sc in each st across (10)

46. Row: inc, 7 sc, dec (10)
47. Row: 1 sc in each st across (10)
48. Row: inc, 7 sc, dec (10)

50. – 55. Row: 1 sc in each st across (10)

67. – 71. Row: 1 sc in each st across (12)
72. Row: 11 sc, inc (13)
73. Row: inc, 12 sc (14)
74. Row: 13 sc, 3 sc in last st (16)
75. Row: 2x inc, 14 sc (18)
76. Row: dec, 15 sc, inc (18)
77. Row: 16 sc, dec (17)
78. Row: dec, 14 sc, inc (17)
79. Row: inc, 14 sc, dec (17)
80. Row: dec, 13 sc, 2x inc (18)
81. Row: 2x inc, 14 sc, dec (19)
82. Row: dec, 16 sc, inc (19)

103. – 107. Row: 1 sc in each st across (23)

Fasten off and weave in both yarn ends.
