



# CROCHET CHERRY



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### What do you need:

- *Super fine* yarn (at a recommended hook size of 2.5-3.5 mm). I used Cotone Uni by Lana Grossa (in the colours “Bordeaux (059)” and “Linden Green (073)”; gauge: 10 cm = 23 M)
- I worked with a hook of size 3.00 mm
- Scissors
- fiberfill

**Skill level:** easy

**Finished size (W x H):** appr. 5 x 6.5 cm

The instruction is written in **American English Crochet** terms.

### Abbreviations:

*sc* = single crochet / *inc* = increase / *dec* = decrease / *st*, *sts* = stitch, stitches / *sl st* = slip stitch / *ch* = chain / *YO* = yarn over / *rd* = round / *MR* = magic ring

You crochet in **spiral rounds** (no ch 1 after rd end).

The number in the brackets at each rd end indicates the new number of sts.

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## INSTRUCTIONS

Take a red yarn and work the **BODY**:

- 1. Rd:** 6 sc in MR (6)
- 2. Rd:** inc every st (12)
- 3. Rd:** inc every 2<sup>nd</sup> st (18)
- 4. - 6. Rd:** 1 sc in each st around (18)
- 7. Rd:** dec every 2<sup>nd</sup> st (12)

Fill the body with fiberfill.

- 8. Rd:** dec every st (6)

Dec and close the hole. Leave some 15 cm yarn tail to later sew the **BODY** to the **STEM**.

Repeat **1. – 8. Rd** for the second cherry body.



Take a new yarn in green for the **STEM**:

Ch 15. Starting from the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch st from hook, work 1 sl st in the first 4 sts.

Then, ch 11. Starting from the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch st from hook, work 1 sl st in each of the remaining 10 ch sts, until you reach the first chain.

Continue working 1 sl st in the next 10 ch sts of the second chain.



Weave in the yarn ends and fasten off.

Sew the cherry **BODIES** to the **STEM** using the yarn tails from the cherry **BODIES**. Make a double knot and hide the yarn ends inside the **BODIES**.



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
