

CROCHET PEAR



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What do you need:

- *Super fine* yarn (at a recommended hook size of 2.5-3.5 mm). I used *Cotone Uni* by *Lana Grossa* (in the colours “Linden Green (073)” and “Taupe (030)”); gauge: 10 cm = 23 M)
- I worked with a hook of size 3.00 mm
- Scissors
- fiberfill

Skill level: easy

Finished size (W x H): appr.6 x 9 cm

The instruction is written in **American English Crochet** terms.

Abbreviations:

sc = single crochet / *inc* = increase / *dec* = decrease / *st*, *sts* = stitch, stitches / *sl st* = slip stitch / *ch* = chain / *YO* = yarn over / *rd* = round / *MR* = magic ring

You crochet in **spiral rounds** (no ch 1 after rd end).

The number in the brackets at each rd end indicates the new number of sts.

INSTRUCTIONS

Take a green yarn and work the **BODY**:

- 1. Rd:** 6 sc in MR (6)
- 2. Rd:** inc every st (12)
- 3. Rd:** inc every 2nd st (18)
- 4. Rd:** inc every 3rd st (24)
- 5. Rd:** inc every 4th st (30)
- 6. Rd:** inc every 5th st (36)
- 7. Rd:** inc every 6th st (42)
- 8. – 16. Rd:** 1 sc in each st around (42)
- 17. Rd:** dec every 6th st (36)
- 18. Rd:** dec every 5th st (30)
- 19. Rd:** 1 sc in each st around (30)
- 20. Rd:** dec every 4th st (24)
- 21. + 22. Rd:** 1 sc in each st around (24)

Fill the body with fiberfill.

- 23. Rd:** dec the first 3 st-pairs, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sts, dec next st, 1 sc in each of the next 5 sts, dec the next 2 st-pairs, 1 sc in each of the next 2 sts. (18)
- 24. + 25. Rd:** 1 sc in each st around (18)
- 26. Rd:** dec every 2nd st (12)

Add fiberfill to the body.

- 27. Rd:** 1 sc in each st around (12)
- 28. Rd:** dec every st (6)

Close the hole and sl st in last st.
Weave in yarn tail, make a double knot and hide the end in the body.

Take a new yarn in brown for the **STEM**:

Ch 5. Starting from the 2nd ch from hook, work 1 sl st in the remaining 4 sts (4).



Use both yarn ends of the **STEM** to sew the **STEM** onto the top of the **BODY**. Thereby, go from top to bottom and pull the yarn ends tightly to give the pear its typical shape. Then, knot the yarn ends at the bottom together several times while further pulling the ends tightly to add shape to the pear bottom. Hide the yarn tail inside the **BODY**.



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
